RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION TO THE METRO-EAST PARK AND RECREATION DISTRICT (MEPRD) FY 21 PARK AND TRAIL GRANT PROGRAM FOR MATCHING FUNDS FOR THE TRAIL EXTENSION FROM THE MADISON COUNTY TRANSIT (MCT) DISTRICT TRAIL ALONG ROUTE 40 INTO AND THROUGH THE TRI-TOWNSHIP PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Troy, Illinois, has identified an opportunity to secure matching funds from the Metro-East Park and Recreation District's FY 21 Park and Trail Grant Program for the enhancement of a bicycle trail path on the east side of Spring Valley Road from the Madison County Transit (MCT) Bicycle Trail at the US Highway 40 intersection into and through the Tri-Township Park District property, for eventual extension into the downtown area of the City of Troy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has previously appropriated TIF funds for the engineering and construction of said bicycle path within the City's current fiscal year budget; and

WHEREAS, through Ordinance 2020-18, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has partnered with the Tri-Township Park District to secure the necessary easements for 20-year control of said bicycle path, with provisions in partnership for maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the Metro-East Park and Recreation District program, upon successful application, will provide up to 40 percent in matching funds (\$300,000 maximum) towards the overall construction costs of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
2. The City of Troy, Illinois, shall apply for an FY 21 Park and Trail Grant with the Metro-East Park and Recreation District for up to \$300,000 in matching funds, dependent on engineer's estimate of final project cost.
3. The City of Troy, Illinois, shall match with up to and, likely, exceeding \$450,000 in City Tax Increment Financing (TIF) funds, upon successful awarding from the Metro-East Park and Recreation District for the FY 21 Park and Trail Grant program.
4. That the Mayor, on behalf of the City of Troy, Illinois, execute such documents and all other documents necessary for the carrying out of said grant applications.
5. That the Mayor is authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.
6. This Resolution shall be in effect following its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
7. Any and all Resolutions, sections or subsections of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

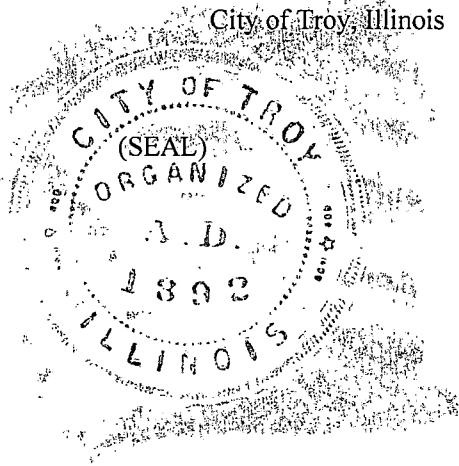
