**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS  
SUPPORTING THE CITY'S APPLICATION FOR THE  
MADISON COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Troy, Illinois, is applying to Madison County for Fiscal Year 2018 Environmental Grant Program funding; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary that an application be made for and agreements entered into with Madison County, Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Troy, Illinois, finds storm water erosion threatens the operation of the High Meadows Sanitary Sewer Lift Station at 607 Riggin Road; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Troy, Illinois, has identified storm water erosion is damaging private property at 445 Bluebird Lane and 610 Sparrow Court; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 1451 creates an automatic approval timeline, which is one-sided and detrimental to the public, presuming that municipalities are negligent and providers not-when a permit is incomplete or inadequate; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Troy, Illinois, endeavors to correct the storm water erosion and improve bank stabilization to Wendell Branch Tributary; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Troy, Illinois, acknowledges a 20 percent minimum local match required for a successful application for said program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
2. The City of Troy shall apply for FY 18 Madison County Environmental Grant Program funding under the terms and conditions of Madison County and shall enter into and agree to the understandings and assurances in said applications.
3. The proposed project description shall be identified as the High Meadows storm water erosion and bank stabilization improvements.
4. A copy of this resolution as passed shall be included in the application to Madison County.

5. The City of Troy will contribute a 20 percent minimum local match to supplement a Madison County Sustainability Grant Program award of up to \$15,000.
6. The Mayor and City Administrator are authorized to provide such additional information as may be required to accomplish the obtaining of such grant.
7. This Resolution shall be in effect following its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
8. Any and all Resolutions, sections or subsections of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
