**Resolution No. 2017-08**  
**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS**  
**APPROVING STREET CLOSURES FOR THE**  
**ANNUAL TROY LIONS HOMECOMING PARADE**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017-08**

WHEREAS, the Troy Lions Club is sponsoring a Homecoming Parade in the City of Troy, Illinois, which event constitutes a public purpose;

WHEREAS, this Parade will require the temporary closure of Market Street, a State highway in the City of Troy from Hassinger Avenue to Wickliffe Street and will end at the Veterans Memorial in the Tri-Township Park.

WHEREAS, Section 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code authorizes the Department of Transportation to issue permits to local authorities to temporarily close portions of State Highways for such public purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Troy that permission to close off Market Street from Hassinger Avenue to Wickliffe Street and will end at the Veterans Memorial in the Tri-Township Park as above designated, be requested of the Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this closure shall occur during the approximate time period between 5 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. on July 21, 2017 and July 22, 2017.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traffic from that closed portion of highway shall be detoured over routes with an all-weather surface that can accept the anticipated traffic, which will be maintained to the satisfaction of the Department and which is conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from the State highway. (The parking of vehicles shall be prohibited on the detour routes to allow an uninterrupted flow of two-way traffic.)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that The City of Troy assumes full responsibility for the direction, protection, and regulation of the traffic while the detour is in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that police officers or authorized flaggers shall, at the expense of The City of Troy, be positioned at each end of the closed section, and at other points (such as intersections) as may be necessary to assist in directing traffic through the detour.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that police officers, flaggers and officials shall permit emergency vehicles in emergency situations to pass through the closed area as swiftly as is safe for all concerned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all debris shall be removed by The City of Troy prior to reopening the State highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such signs, flags, barricades, etc., shall be used by The City of Troy as may be approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation. These items shall be provided by the City of Troy, Illinois.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the closure and detour shall be marked according to the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an occasional break shall be made in the procession so that traffic may pass through. In any event, adequate provisions will be made for traffic on intersecting highways pursuant to conditions noted above. (Note: This paragraph is applicable when the Resolution pertains to a parade or when no detour is required.)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the fullest extent permitted by law, the Troy Lions Club shall be responsible for any and all injuries to persons or damage to property, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Illinois Department of Transportation, its officers, employees and agents from any and all claims, lawsuits, actions, costs and fees (including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses) of every nature or description, arising out of, resulting from or connected with exercise of authority granted by the Department which is subject of this resolution. The obligation is binding upon the Troy Lions Club regardless of whether or not such claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by the act, omission or negligence of the Department or its officers, employees or agents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Troy Lions Club shall provide a comprehensive general liability insurance policy or an additional named insured endorsement in the amount of \$100,000,000 per person and \$200,000,000 aggregate which has the Illinois Department of Transportation and its officials, employees and agents as insureds and which protects them from all claims arising from the requested road closing. A copy of said policy or endorsement will be provided to the Department before the road is closed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Department of Transportation, District 8, to serve as a formal request for the permission sought in this resolution and to operate as part of the conditions as said permission.



The Troy Lions Club will be sponsoring the 76<sup>th</sup> Annual Troy Homecoming on Thursday through Saturday, July 20, 21 and 22, 2017, at the Tri-Township Park. Based on the continued positive feedback we received, we will repeat the event on Thursday night as "Family Night", which includes a Children's Parade and discounted amusement rides. Other activities planned for Thursday night include performances by Big Papa G, and the Food Trucks are returning. As in years past, and in keeping with the "Family" theme, no alcohol will be served on Thursday evening.

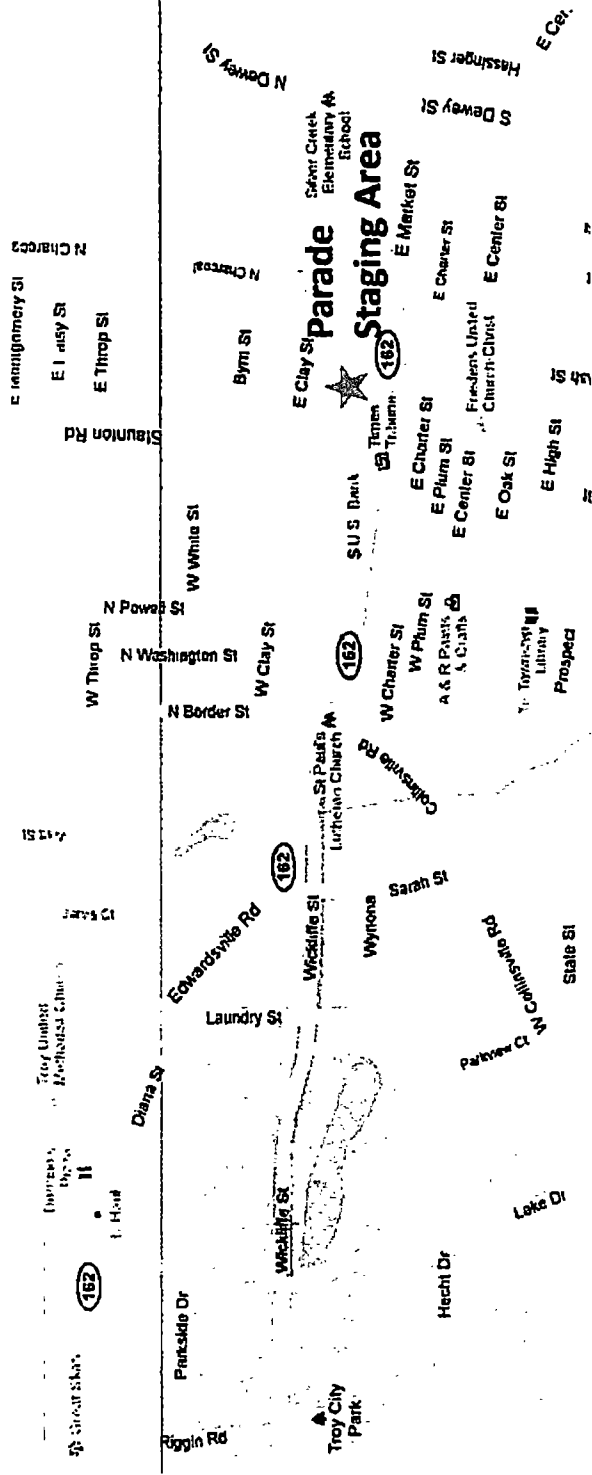


Dear Mayor Adomite:
