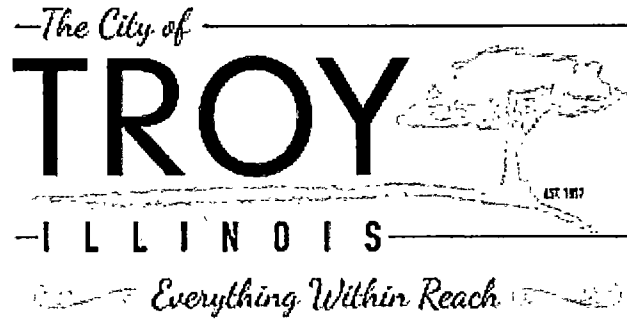

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS,  
HONORING THE LIFE AND MOURNING THE DEATH OF  
ALDERMAN JAMES (TEX) DANIEL**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor, Clerk, Treasurer, members of the City Council, staff and employees of the City of Troy, Illinois, are saddened by the death of our friend and colleague, Alderman James (Tex) Daniel, who passed away on July 9, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, MSgt James Edward (Tex) Daniel USAF Retired, 67, of Troy, was born August 16, 1949 in Dallas, TX, and married Patricia Keenan on April 16, 1971; and, together, they raised three daughters and have five grandchildren, and have been longtime residents of the City of Troy; and

**WHEREAS**, James (Tex) Daniel served his country for 24 years in the United States Air Force, retiring as a MSgt, and then owned and operated the J.I.L. Construction Company, and then proceeded to work as a civilian contractor in Kuwait; and

**WHEREAS**, James (Tex) Daniel was an active member with the Troy Lion's Club, the Bethel Baptist Church, the VFW, the Society of Logistics Engineers, the Non-Commission Officer Association, the Southern Illinois Antique Tractor Club, the Barber Shop Harmony Society, and actively supported the Troy Community Band; and

**WHEREAS**, James (Tex) Daniel will be remembered as a family man, a devoted husband to his wife Patti, and father to his three daughters, whom he coached in many sports activities and never missed a single musical concert; and

**WHEREAS**, James (Tex) Daniel and his tremendous commitment to and spirit in community volunteerism was recognized by the community through his election to the Troy City Council on April 4, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, James (Tex) Daniel is survived by his wife, Patricia of Troy, IL; daughters, Suzanne (Jerry) Jarrell of Troy, IL, Stephanie (Lanny) Stottmeister of Fishers, IN, Sherrie (Hecham Al Homs) Daniel of Troy, IL; grandchildren, Jade Madyson Jarrell, Austin James Jarrell, Tristan Anthony Stottmeister, Peyton Alexis Stottmeister and Aal Hecham Al Homs; brothers, William (Dixie), Michael and Joseph Daniel, all of Louisville, KY; and his extended family and many friends; and

**WHEREAS**, after a heroic fight with cancer and associated illnesses, James (Tex) Daniel was laid to rest on Friday, July 14, 2017, with full military honors at Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery in St. Louis, MO.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

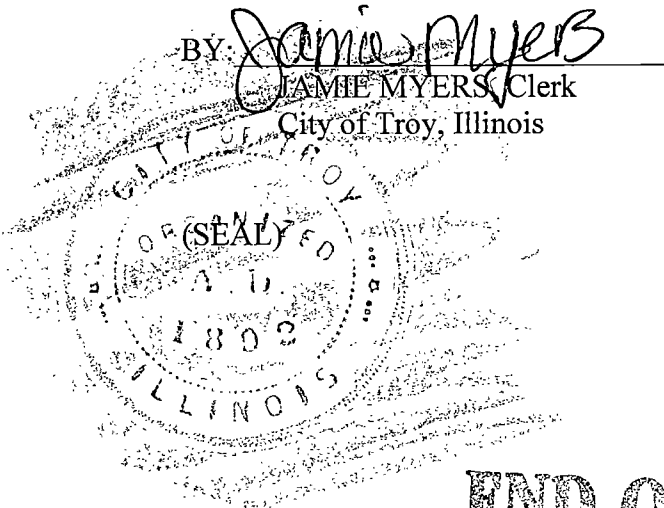
