**ORDINANCE NO. 2020 - 10**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS AMENDING ITS CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE THAT VIOLATIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE ORDERS ISSUED BY THE GOVERNOR RELATED TO COVID-19 BE DECLARED A PUBLIC NUISANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Troy, Illinois, has enacted its Code of Ordinances for the purpose of improving and protecting the public health, safety, comfort, convenience and general welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the position of the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, that executive orders in furtherance of the public health, safety, and welfare lawfully issued by the Governor of the State of Illinois by the powers vested in Article 5 of the Illinois Constitution and Sections 7(1), 7(2), 7(8), 7(10), and 7(12) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305, and consistent with the powers in public health laws, shall be observed and obeyed by the citizens of the City of Troy, Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, accordingly, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, hereby amend its Code of Ordinances to provide that violations of these lawful executive orders are hereby declared a public nuisance.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2:** Chapter 131 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Troy, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following:

**Chapter 131: OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY, PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY**

**Section 131.40 – VIOLATION OF EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDERS**

**Sec. 1. - Purposes of this article.**

Executive orders in furtherance of the public health, safety, and welfare lawfully issued by the Governor of the State of Illinois by the powers vested in Article 5 of the Illinois Constitution and Sections 7(1), 7(2), 7(8), 7(10), and 7(12) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305, and consistent with the powers in public health laws, shall be observed and obeyed by the citizens of the City of Troy. Violations of these lawful executive orders are hereby declared a public nuisance.

Sec. 2. – Violation of an Executive Order.

It shall be unlawful for any person, partnership, joint adventure, association, society, club, trustee or corporation or any officer, agent, employee, factor or any kind of personal representative to violate any Executive Order of the Governor of the State of Illinois pursuant to the Governor’s powers under Article 5 of the Illinois Constitution and Sections 7(1), 7(2), 7(8), 7(10), and 7(12) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305.

Sec. 3. – Penalties.

(a) Any person or entity having been found guilty of violating any Executive Order of the Governor of the State of Illinois pursuant to the Governor’s powers under Article 5 of the Illinois Constitution and Sections 7(1), 7(2), 7(8), 7(10), and 7(12) of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305 shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$750 per day that such offense continues; and

(b) Any person or entity having been found guilty of violating Sec. 2 herein shall be liable for a fine on a continuing basis and shall be subject to a \$750 fine for each day that said violation continues.

Sec. 4. If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstances is ruled unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid application or provision, and each invalid provision or invalid application of this Ordinance is severable.

Sec. 5. Effective Immediately.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage due to the immediate urgency of implementing the Illinois Governor’s Emergency Orders issued in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency.

**PASSED** by the City Council of the City of Troy, Madison County, Illinois, approved by the Mayor, and deposited in the office of the City Clerk this 6<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2020.


