AN ORDINANCE Amending Chapters
31 and 32 of the Troy Municipal Code
Regarding the Compensation of Elected Officials

ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TROY, ILLINOIS
THIS 8TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER 2020

Whereas, the City of Troy, Illinois, presently has in force Chapter 31, Section 32, and Chapter 32, Sections 51, 64 & 81, which authorize compensation for elected officials; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois, has performed a regular review of its elected officials' compensation every four years, for the purpose of setting new salaries by the deadline outlined in the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-50-10); and

Whereas, the Illinois Municipal Code states: "The corporate authorities of a municipality may fix the salaries of all municipal officers and employees in the

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annual appropriation or budget ordinance. They may fix the salary of all officers who hold elective office for a definite term in an ordinance other than the appropriation or budget ordinance. The salaries that are fixed in the annual appropriation ordinance shall neither be increased nor diminished during the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made. The salaries that are fixed by ordinance for those officers who hold elective office for a definite term shall neither be increased nor diminished during that term and shall be fixed at least 180 days before the beginning of the terms of the officers whose compensation is to be fixed"; and

Whereas, the City of Troy, Illinois, recognizes a deadline of November 3, 2020 as the deadline to enact new compensation schedules for elected officials for the terms commencing from May 3, 2021 through May 5, 2025; and

Whereas, the City Council has duly considered the matter at the Administrative & Community Services Committee meeting held on Saturday, August 29, 2020, and has determined and concluded that it is in the best interest of the City, and in compliance with the powers conferred upon the City by the State of Illinois through 50 ILCS 145/2, to amend the existing Chapters 31 and 32 of Troy Municipal Code of Ordinances regarding elected official compensation for the offices of Mayor, City Clerk, City Treasurer and Alderman.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: The recitals contained above in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby incorporated herein by reference, the same as if set forth in this Section of this Ordinance verbatim, as findings of the City Council of the City of Troy, Illinois

SECTION 2: That *Chapters 31 and 32* of the Troy Municipal Code of Ordinances is amended as described in Exhibit A.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or resolutions, or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict, are hereby changed and amended to comply with this Ordinance; and to the extent the same cannot be so amended, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 4: That if any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections or provisions of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid section or provision, and to this end, the sections and provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law and shall be published in pamphlet form by the authority of the City Council.



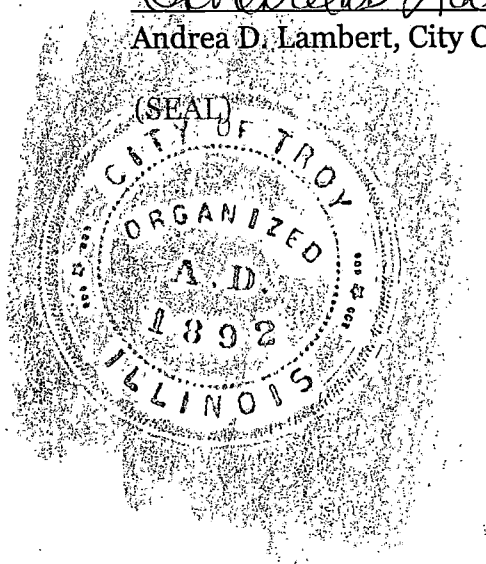


Exhibit A

Chapter 31.32 – COMPENSATION

- (A) The Mayor shall receive as his or her compensation for the performance of his or her duties the amount of ~~\$15,000.00~~ **\$15,000.00** annually for the 12-month period beginning ~~May 1, 2017~~ **May 1, 2021** through ~~April 30, 2018~~ **April 30, 2022**. Thereafter, the compensation paid to the Mayor for the performance of his or her duties shall remain the same, without any annual increments, for the periods of May 1, 2018~~22~~ through April 30, 2019~~23~~; May 1, 2019~~23~~ through April 30, 2020~~24~~; and May 1, 2020~~24~~ through April 30, 2021~~25~~. The Mayor's salary shall be paid to the Mayor in 12 equal monthly installments.
- (C) An Alderman shall receive as compensation for the performance of his or her duties the amount of ~~\$7,500.00~~ **\$7,500.00** annually for the 12-month period beginning ~~May 1, 2017~~ **May 1, 2021** through ~~April 30, 2018~~ **April 30, 2022**. Thereafter, the compensation paid to an Alderman for the performance of his or her duties shall remain the same, without any annual increments, for the periods of May 1, 2018~~22~~ through April 30, 2019~~23~~; May 1, 2019~~23~~ through April 30, 2020~~24~~; and May 1, 2020~~24~~ through April 30, 2021~~25~~. An Alderman's salary shall be paid to the Alderman in 12 equal monthly installments.

Chapter 32.051 – COMPENSATION

- ~~(A) The City Clerk shall receive as his or her compensation for the performance of his or her duties the amount of \$40,000.00 annually for the 12-month period beginning May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2018. Thereafter, the compensation paid to the City Clerk for the performance of his or her duties shall remain the same, without any annual increments, for the periods of May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019; May 1, 2019 through April 30, 2020; and May 1, 2020 through April 30, 2021. The City Clerk shall be eligible to participate in the city's health insurance coverage plan with the same terms and conditions offered to all other non-bargaining unit employees of the city.~~
- ~~(B) If the City Clerk makes the election to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, which the City Clerk is entitled to make pursuant to § 7-137 of the Illinois Pension Code, the City Clerk's total salary in each of the four successive one-year periods, beginning on May 1, 2017, shall be the City Clerk's basic salary specified in division (A) of this section, plus whatever contribution the city is required by law to make to the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund for the City Clerk.~~
- ~~(C) The City Clerk's basic salary shall be paid to the City Clerk in 26 equal biweekly installments.~~

The City Clerk shall receive as his or her compensation for the performance of his or her duties the amount of \$7,500.00 annually for the 12-month period beginning May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022. Thereafter, the compensation paid to the City Clerk for the performance of his or her duties shall remain the same, without any annual increments, for the periods of May 1, 2022 through April 30, 2023; May 1, 2023 through April 30, 2024; and May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2025. The City Clerk's salary shall be paid to the City Clerk in 12 equal monthly installments.

Chapter 32.064 – APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY CLERK

The City Clerk is authorized to appoint a Deputy Clerk of the city. The Clerk is directed to notify the City Council of the appointment of a Deputy Clerk and to issue appropriate credentials evidencing the appointment to the occupant of that office. **It is the legislative intent of the City Council for an Administrative Clerk to be provided by the city administration for the purposes of the preparation of materials to assist the City Clerk in his or her duties. This Administrative Clerk may or may not be the Deputy Clerk.**

Chapter 32.081 – COMPENSATION

The City Treasurer shall receive as his or her compensation for the performance of his or her duties the amount of ~~\$12,000.00~~ **\$7,500.00** annually for the 12-month period beginning ~~May 1, 2017~~ **May 1, 2021** through ~~April 30, 2018~~ **April 30, 2022**. Thereafter, the compensation paid to the City Treasurer for the performance of his or her duties shall remain the same, without any annual increments, for the periods of ~~May 1, 2018~~ **May 1, 2022** through ~~April 30, 2019~~ **April 30, 2023**; ~~May 1, 2019~~ **May 1, 2023** through ~~April 30, 2020~~ **April 30, 2024**; and ~~May 1, 2020~~ **May 1, 2024** through ~~April 30, 2021~~ **April 30, 2025**. The City Treasurer's salary shall be paid to the City Treasurer in 12 equal monthly installments.

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
