A. Agenda Items

1. Call to Order

A public hearing was held in the Council Chambers in the City Municipal Building, 116 East Market Street, Troy, Illinois, 62294. The hearing was called to order by Mayor David Nonn at 7:00 p.m.

3. Discuss Draft of 2021-2022 Annual Appropriations Ordinance

City Treasurer Huelsmann presented the Annual Appropriations Ordinance to the City Council. This ordinance is a required step in the truth-in-taxation cycle and sets the legal limit on spending by the City. The former city administrator prepared the budget which was passed by the council in April. This appropriations ordinance increases limits by 20 percent to allow the city to fund unexpected expenses which may be incurred. In the event we have to use any overage set by the ordinance, we would need to cut expenses in another area. A \$3 million dollar contingency fund is included to allow legal spending in extreme emergencies. Again, we do not intend to spend beyond the limits of the existing budget. Once approved, this ordinance will be used to write the tax levy ordinance in December.

Mayor Nonn asked if the council members had any questions. He then called for public comment.
